4. Recipient must have been an active participant with an organization that promotes community service, for at least two (2) cumulative years prior to high school graduation.
5. Recipient must be a resident of Hampton Roads, Virginia.
6. Recipient must submit a minimum of a 300 word essay, 12-point font, double-spaced and typewritten.
